2. ENTRY DEADLINE OCTOBER 3, 2025

3. ALL ENTRIES must be accompanied by a valid negative pullorum/typhoid test certificate administered 90 days of the show. N.P.I.P certificate. All birds must meet Minnesota regulations for the exhibition including a leg band or wing band. Turkeys must be tested for Mycoplasma Gallisepticum and Mycoplasma Synovae.

4. All breeds that included bearded and non-bearded or single comb and rosecomb varieties should be identified specifically.

5. A junior is a youth who is 18 and under. APA rules govern; Open Show is different birds.

6. The Minnesota State Poultry Association has accepted specialty meets from various clubs but will not be held responsible for such awards.

7. Birds are to be handled by the owner, judge and show officials only. Any person interfering with judging will have his/her birds disqualified.

8. All eggs laid during the show are property of Minnesota State Poultry Association. Only show officials are authorized to remove eggs from cages.

9. A display of chickens, turkeys and guineas will consist of cock, hen, cockerel, pullet and a young or old trio. A display in waterfowl will consist of old male, old female, young male, young female and 3 more birds. Point system per APA rules will govern.

10. Building will be open on Friday, October 24th at 11:00 a.m.- 10:00 p.m. All birds must be cooped in by 9:00 A.M., Saturday, October 25th. JUDGING BEGINS Saturday, October 25th at 9:00a.m. All birds must remain on exhibit until the awards have been given out on SUNDAY, October 26th.

11. American Poultry Association rules will govern this show. Any situation not provided for in these rules will be referred to the Officers of the M.S.P.A. and their decision is final.

12. All sick birds will be removed from the showroom by Show Management. Neither M.S.P.A. nor its officers are responsible for any loss, sickness or injury to any birds brought to the show.

13. Feed and water will be supplied, but all exhibitors will be responsible for the feeding and watering of their own birds.

14. ABSOLUTELY NO ENTRY CHANGES AT SHOWROOM. We are completely computerized. NO REFUNDS ON ENTRY FEES.

SHOWMANSHIP CONTEST: Saturday, October 25th, 9:00 A.M.

- Agribition Building. Each Junior must bring one bird of their choice (Chicken, Duck, Goose or Turkey) to the ring to be judged. YOU, the exhibitor, will be judged on the appearance of your bird, your knowledge of the bird, how you handle the bird and your general poultry enthusiasm. We will have seating and a sound system so all can hear and see the placings.
- RULES: We prefer you pre-register on your entry to be in the showmanship contest. There is no entry fee for showmanship.
- Age groups are:
 - 9 years and under
 - 10-14 years
 - 15-18 years of age
- Be sure to include your age group on your entry. You must bring an extra bird for showmanship. This will allow the Junior Judge to finish each class uninterrupted. This bird can be borrowed from a friend.

JUNIOR SHOW AWARDS:

The Minnesota State Poultry Association will award Medallions to the top three (3) in each age class. A Junior is a youth who is 18 years of age or younger. The Junior Show will be SEPARATE from the open show. A Junior can also show in the open show with different birds.

The Junior show will be held in the Agribition Building. All judging will be by the latest edition of the American Standard of Perfection copyrighted by the American Poultry Association, Inc. Application for membership maybe made at the show or may be sent to the American Poultry Association but must be prior to judging to be eligible for the APA awards.
